Encouraging Use of Bicycles

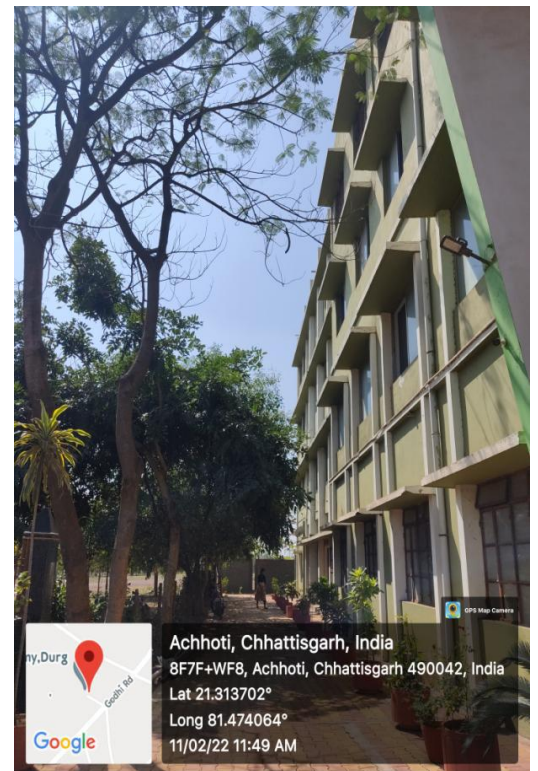
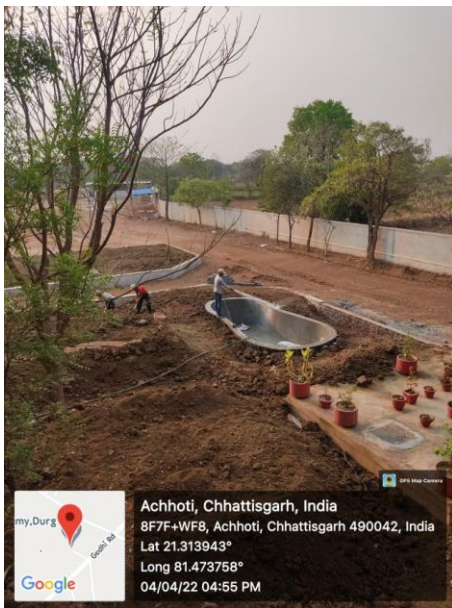
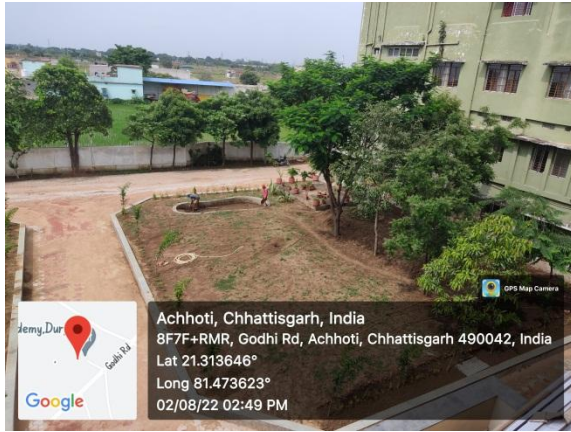

- Students and teachers are encouraged to **carry water in steel/glass (Permanent) bottles in spite of plastic bottles.**
- There are **no plastic plates, plastic glasses and spoons or straws** used in our canteen or in college function instead **biodegradable utensils** are used.
- More students now carry their own bottles, which they can refill at the College’s water filters.
- At college and hostels, guests and visiting faculty are no longer offered those small, disposable bottles; conference rooms have water jugs and glasses.
- Students also amped up efforts to spread awareness following the enforcement of the ban also put up posters and banners to encourage people to polythene free environment & “Only One Earth” Awareness Program.

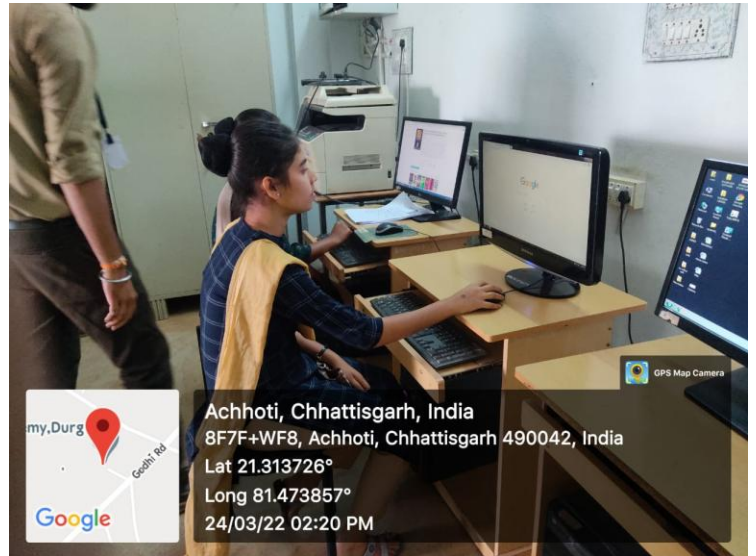


Move toward Paperless Office/Campus

- **Customized digital forms** are used in spite of physically on paper forms.

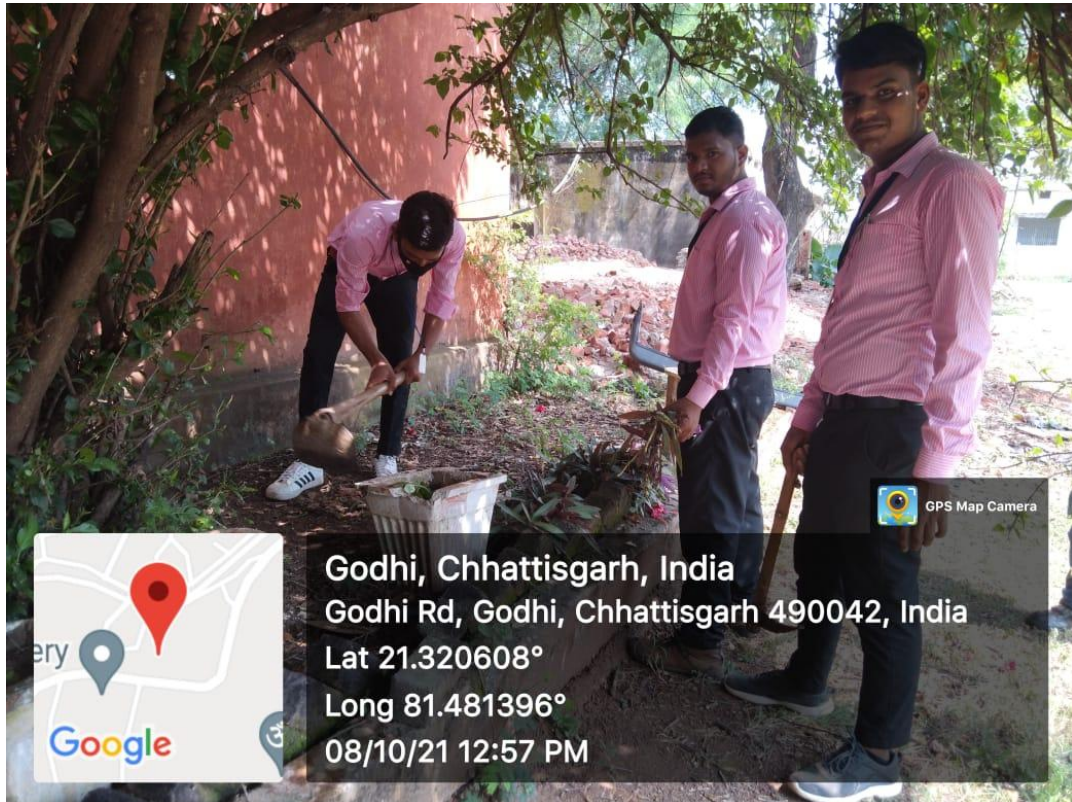

- Time to time awareness programs & plantation programs are organizing in campus an outside also as practice.

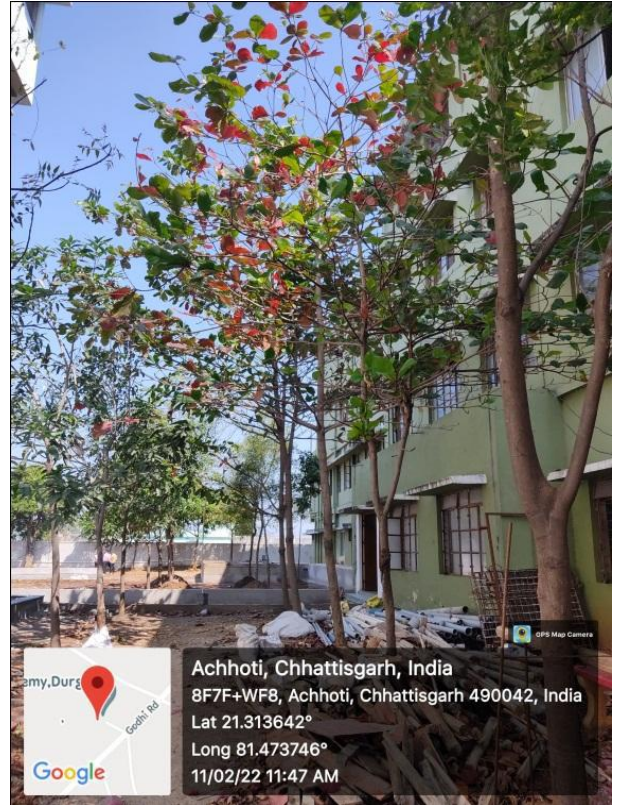






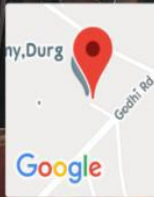
