Keynote Address Summary



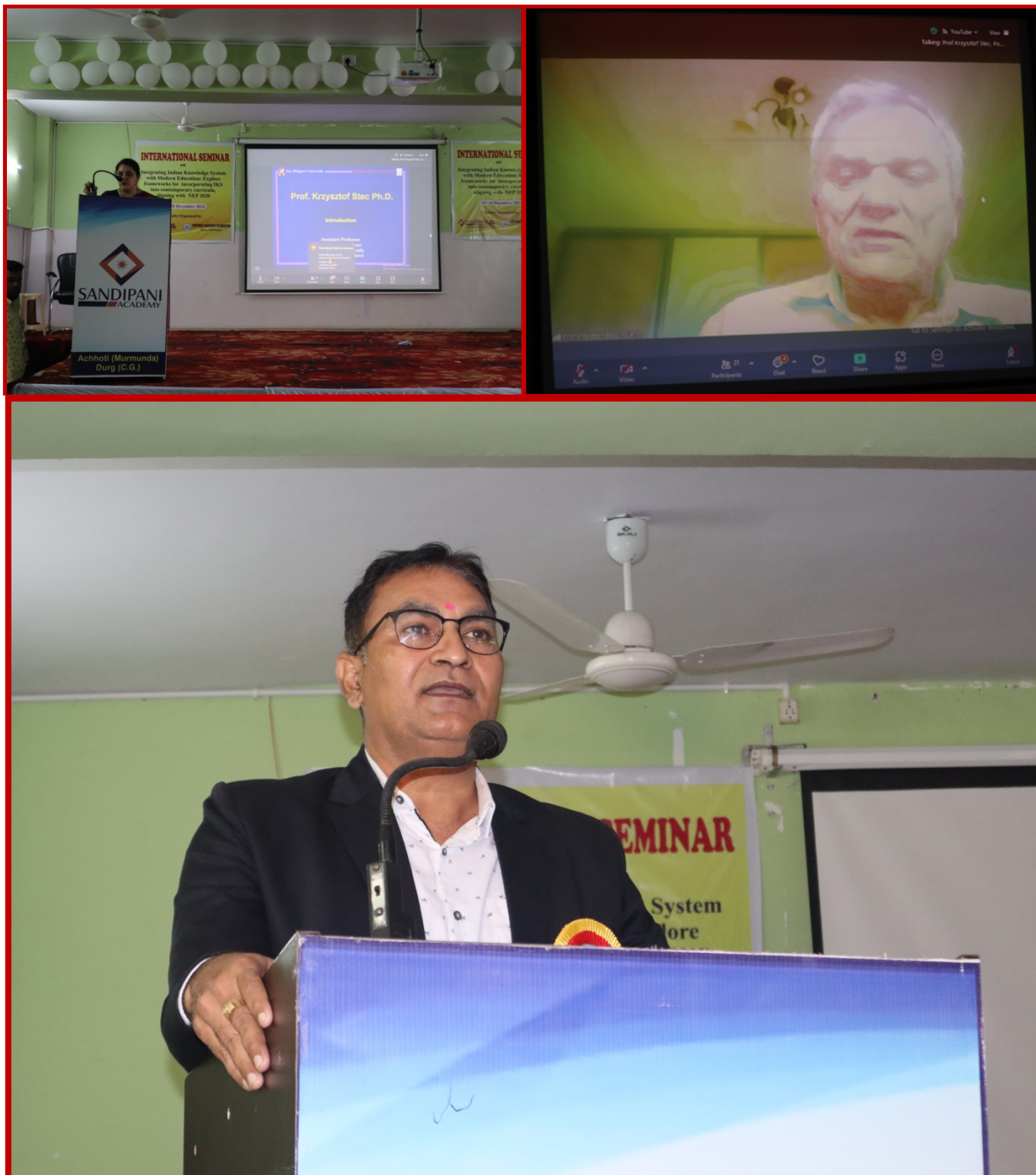
Dr. Deepa Dass Ji's keynote address set the stage for a comprehensive discussion on reviving and integrating the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) within modern education. Her speech emphasized the critical need to align traditional wisdom with contemporary academic structures, ensuring that Indian heritage and scientific thought find a place within the formal education framework envisioned by National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Dr. Deepa Dass Ji proposed structured methodologies to integrate IKS within mainstream education:

- Curricular Inclusion: Infusing elements of Vedic mathematics, Ayurveda, Yoga, Sanskrit literature, and Indic sciences within school and higher education syllabi.
- Research and Documentation: Encouraging students and scholars to engage in research projects exploring the relevance of ancient Indian texts in contemporary contexts.
- Experiential and Practical Learning: Introducing workshops, heritage-based education programs, and traditional craft-based learning to make IKS engaging and applicable.
- Teacher Training & Pedagogical Innovations: Educating teachers on indigenous methodologies to enable contextualized and culturally relevant teaching.
- Technology Integration: Leveraging AI, VR, and digital platforms to create immersive learning experiences around IKS.

Dr. Deepa Dass Ji's keynote address provided a roadmap for seamlessly integrating India's indigenous knowledge into the modern education system. 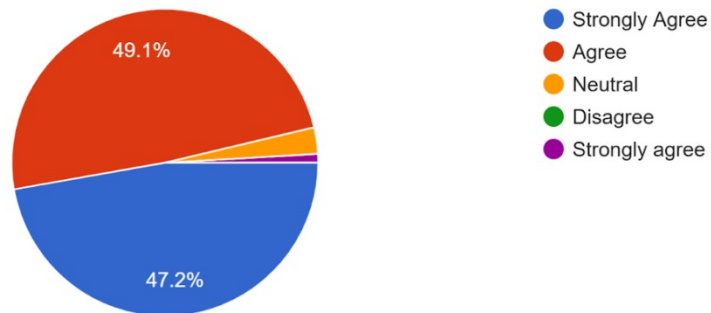

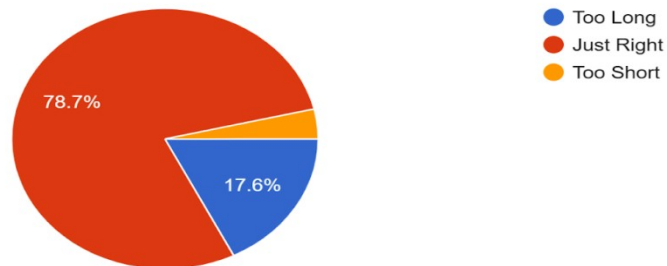

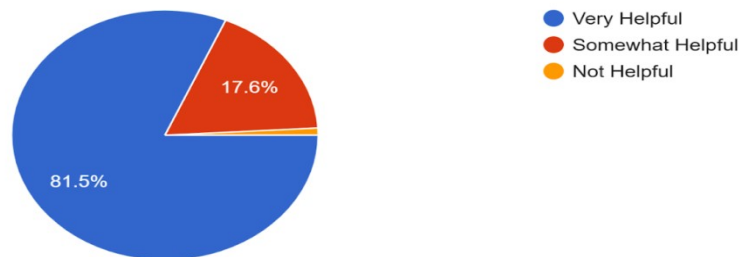
b) Was the duration of the program appropriate?

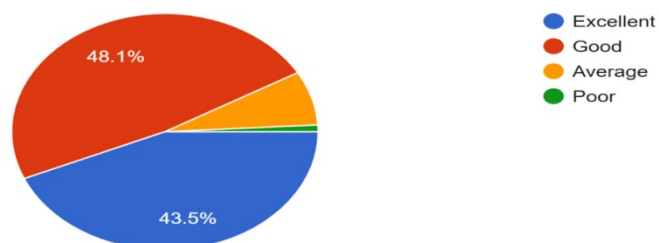

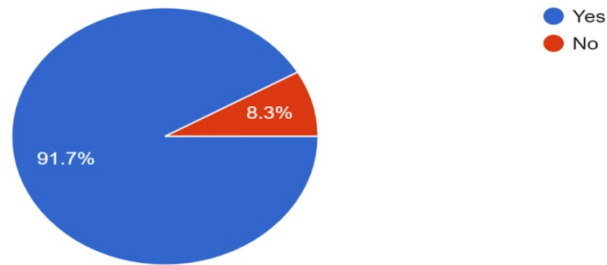

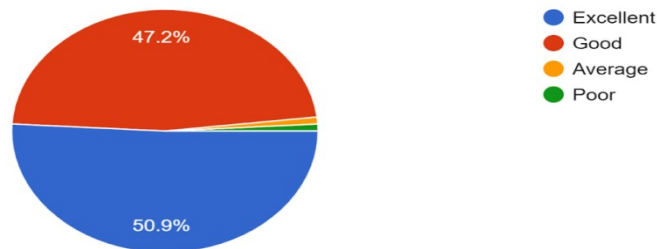

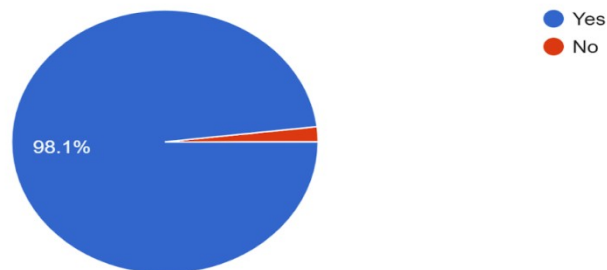
